

# ZONAMACO CELEBRATES 15 YEARS WITH 170 EXHIBITORS FROM 27 COUNTRIES

The 15th edition of Z<sub>2</sub>ONAMACO México Arte Contemporáneo and the 8th edition of Z<sub>2</sub>ONAMACO Diseño will gather 170 multinational exhibitors and over 60,000 visitors.

Z<sub>0</sub>ONAMACO México Arte Contemporáneo and Z<sub>0</sub>ONAMACO Diseño announce the list of the 170 exhibitors selected for their 2018 edition, to be held from February 7th to the 11th, at Centro Citibanamex in Mexico City.

Drawn from 27 countries across America, Europe and Asia, the exhibitors present works ranging from Modern pieces to new works by both established and emerging artists, as well as furniture and design objects produced during a period that goes from 1920 to the most recent trends.
