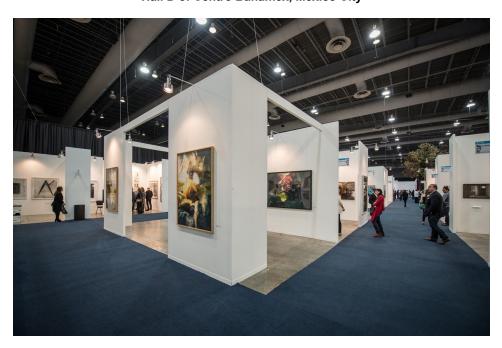


## Z®ONAMACO FOTO announces participating galleries for its 2016 edition
